



## 3rd UK Coloured Pencil Society Online Exhibition

Closing Date for Entries 5<sup>th</sup> November 2019

### CALL FOR ENTRIES

This is a members-only exhibition. All work must be original in concept, design and execution. The artist must demonstrate compositional and drawing skills and the ability to use coloured pencils. Entries may have been shown in previous UKCPS exhibitions providing they were not award winners.

The Society has the right to refuse to accept works not meeting all conditions set out in this document. In the event of a challenge, it is the artist's responsibility to ensure that their work is in compliance. The Society may refuse to exhibit work not up to the entry submission standard.

Eligible:

- Each work submitted MUST comprise at least 50% dry coloured pencil (i.e. wood-cased wax- or oil-based coloured pencil, including watercolour pencil if used dry).
- The remaining 50% of the work MAY be in any other medium.
- Any photographic reference used as the entire or majority source must be taken by the artist or used with the express permission of the copyright owner.

Ineligible:

- An image produced by drawing over a digital reproduction.
- Artwork executed in whole or part under instruction and/or in any teaching or workshop situation.
- Use of an individual's image without that individual's permission, in accordance with UK privacy laws.

### Entry Fees

£6 per entry (maximum 3 entries) – all fees are non-refundable.

### Method of Submission

Entry by JPG image only, resolution 300dpi and maximum size 5MB. The file name of each image should contain the artist's surname and title of work in this format (e.g. John\_Constable-The\_Haywain). Images to be uploaded via the online entry form. No postal entries.

Entry form to include title of picture and size of unframed work in centimetres.

The artist grants permission for the Society's use of the accepted images for publicity and promotion for purposes wholly related to UKCPS.
